Weekly plan 4th week of November: 20.11.2023 to 23.11.2023



Communication and Language

This week, students will explore vocabulary related to land, air, and water transport, including vehicles, traffic safety, traffic lights, pedestrians, and zebra crossings. Activities will involve examining various types of transport and discussing when and by whom they are used. Children will provide examples of transportation for water, air, and land. Additionally, discussions will focus on emergency vehicles such as ambulances, fire engines, and police cars, exploring their importance and helpfulness.

New Vocabulary for this week:

land, air, and water transport, vehicles, traffic safety, traffic lights, pedestrians, and zebra crossings, ambulances, fire engines, and police cars.

Mathematics

In the upcoming week, children will focus on learning numbers 17 and 18, engaging in activities such as tracing, colouring, and drawing these numbers. They will identify the number 'what comes before 1 – 10'. The differentiation activities include recognizing, tracing, and writing numbers 17 and 18 with corresponding quantities, counting the number of students in their class, differentiating between tens and ones, drawing a zebra crossing and labelling it with the numbers, and arranging cars on the road in backward counting. It's a week of numeracy exploration and creative exercises.

Number for the week: 17 and 18

Literacy

In the upcoming week, children will focus on the letters "Zz" and "Ww" and learn related vocabulary such as zebra, buzz, zap, wind, window, web, wig, and swam. Differentiation activities will include a hidden game in the classroom involving the vocabulary words, playing puzzle games with jumbled sounds, and practicing the name, sounds, and vocabulary of the letters while reading associated words.

Letters for the week : 'Ww' – 'Zz'

New Vocabulary for this week:

zebra, buzz, zap, wind, window, web, wig, and swam.

Personal, Social, Emotional

This week, children are asked to bring their toy vehicles and share their feelings. We'll discuss different types of transportation. They will also talk about road safety and holiday experiences, describing travel destinations and modes of transportation. To spark creativity, students will imagine journeys, thinking about where they would go by plane or boat. These activities aim to foster lively discussions about transportation, safety, and exciting travel adventures.

Understanding the World

Throughout this week, students will engage in various differentiation activities centred around the **theme of transportation**. They will explore different types of transport, discussing when and where each mode would be used and identifying the intended users. Another activity involves **categorizing pictures of various transport modes from magazines into air, land, and water** categories on a chart. Additionally, students will have hands-on experiences, creating paper planes and boats to observe their floating and flying capabilities. To **understand the ability to float, a float and sink** experiment will be set up. The week will conclude with an imaginative journey as students pretend to take a flight on a plane, making the learning experience both educational and enjoyable.

Physical Development

This week, children will participate in outdoor and indoor activities centred around road safety. These activities include walking on the pavement, observing traffic on the road, and practicing walking (not running). Through enactment, children will learn the crucial steps of road safety—stopping, looking, and proceeding. Additionally, they will be actively involved in the practical experience of crossing the road in pairs while holding hands. These engaging activities aim to impart essential road safety skills to children in a hands-on and interactive way.

حرف الزاي (ز): يتعرف الطلاب إلى حرف الزاي اسمًا وصوتًا وشكلًا من خلال البوربوينت والصور والكلمات وسوف يكتبون كلمات جديدة على مدار الأسبوع ، ويشترك الطلاب في الحوار والمناقشة لتنمية مهارة الاستماع والتحدث لديهم خاصة عند الاستماع إلى قصة الحرف وربطها بالواقع، وتسمية مفردات الحرف.

يميز الطلاب الحرف مع أصواته القصيرة الثلاث (الفتحة والضمة والكسرة) من خلال الصور والكلمات وممارسة الأنشطة التعليمية المختلفة مثل مطابقة الصور ومطابقة الحرف بالصور التي تبدأ به بهدف تعزيز مهارة اللغة والقراءة، والتحدي بين الطلاب لغرس روح المنافسة بينهم ، وكتابة الحرف بالشكل الصحيح مع تعزيز قدراتهم الإبداعية.
