Weekly plan 4th week of September: 25.09.2023 to 28.09.2023



Personal, Social, Emotional

The children will be taught by the school nurse about the consequences of neglecting daily tooth brushing, emphasizing the significance of maintaining clean hands and the proper etiquette of covering their mouths and noses with a tissue when they cough or sneeze to prevent the spread of germs. They'll also get to share what makes their homes special and why they love them, creating a blend of hygiene education and emotional connection.

Communication and Language

During the week, the children will encounter new words via a word wall, specifically tailored to the story they're exploring. This vocabulary includes letters and words pertinent to the narrative. They'll discuss and exchange their thoughts on the story and its lessons. Additionally, they'll delve into the topic of germs, discussing the importance of frequent handwashing to promote good personal hygiene. This holistic approach integrates language learning, critical thinking, and hygiene education for a well-rounded educational experience.

Literacy

Children will be focusing on the letters and sounds of "Pp" and "Nn," exploring sight words like "he" and "she" and contrasting opposites like "clean" and "dirty."

Their vocabulary will expand with words such as pencil, parrot, pie, pen, net, nest, neck, and nose. Engaging blending exercises featuring words like "nit," "tin," "nap," "ant," "pan," and "tin" will enhance their language skills.

They'll also be encouraged to develop self-value and pride. They will link their studies the UAE's famous park in Sharjah, and the significant role of nurses in UAE hospitals.

Through hands-on activities like crafting parrots or nests with paper and cotton, as well as building sight words with blocks or cubes, they'll engage in interactive learning. Differentiation through sorting activities and word-picture matching will accommodate diverse learning styles, while encouraging creativity by drawing pictures starting with the initial sounds of "p" and "n." This holistic approach ensures a comprehensive and immersive learning experience for the children.

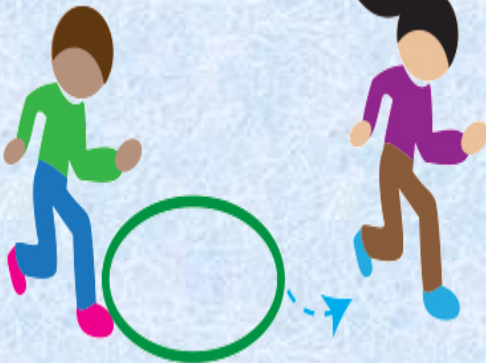
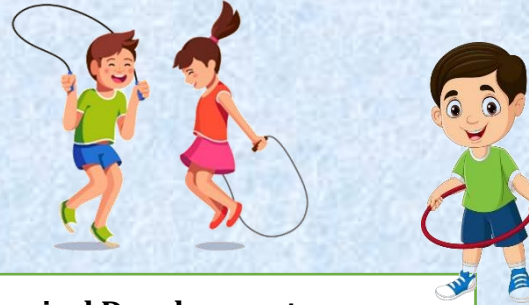
Understanding the World

The primary objectives of this educational session are twofold.

Firstly, it aims to instil in children an appreciation for the significance of hygiene, helping them grasp the importance of cleanliness in their daily lives.

Secondly, it seeks to impart an understanding of essential safety measures. It starts with an engaging experiment showcasing the importance of handwashing using "germy" hands as an illustration.

Differentiation strategies will be employed to cater to varying learning preferences, including engaging craft activities such as creating handwashing and toothbrush crafts, as well as fostering imaginative expression through drawing exercises. This comprehensive approach aims to equip children with practical knowledge and a sense of responsibility for their well-being while nurturing their creativity.



Mathematics

Children will focus on oral counting from 0 to 5 as the central topic. They will begin by introducing the number 5 and exploring its significance in various contexts. They will engage in interactive counting exercises, such as determining the number of tables in the classroom and tallying up their daily good habits. Creativity will come into play as they attempt to draw the number 5.

To cater to diverse learning styles, differentiation will be implemented through tactile activities like crafting the number with playdough and matching quantity cards to their respective numbers. The number sensory bin will provide a hands-on, sensory-rich experience, making the learning process both engaging and comprehensive for the children.

Physical Development

The children will engage in an exciting outdoor skipping race where they'll have to flip a hoop over their heads and then skip through it, adding an element of challenge to the game. To test their understanding, they'll listen and select the appropriate personal hygiene card, ensuring they remember the lessons.

In a fun twist, they'll also get to pretend to be parrots, mimicking the sounds they make, adding a playful element to the activities.
