

UAE NATIONAL AGENDA PARAMETER (NAP)

- UAE National Agenda Parameter is a method for measuring and monitoring schools' progress towards achieving their individual National Agenda targets.
- This parameter requires all schools to participate in international and external benchmarking assessments on an annual basis.
- CAT4, TIMSS, Progress test, PIRLS, PISA *etc.*



Assessments that Come Under NAP

PISA (Program for International Student Assessment)

- Testing the skills and knowledge of 15-year-old students
 - Students were assessed in science, mathematics, reading, collaborative problem solving and financial literacy

PIRLS (Progress in Reading Literacy Study)

- International standard for reading comprehension at the fourth grade, to assess foundational reading skills
- PIRLS is an innovative assessment of online reading that makes it possible for countries to understand how successful they are in preparing fourth grade students to read, comprehend, and interpret online information
- It is conducted by the Internal Association for the Evaluation of Educational Achievement (IEA)
- Next exam in 2021



CAT4 – Cognitive Ability Test (4th Edition)

- Measures ability Grades 3, 4, 6 and 8
- The test is available in both paper and digital formats and can be administered individually or in a group setting
- Assesses a pupil's ability to reason with and manipulate different types of material, through a series of Verbal, Non-verbal, Quantitative and Spatial Reasoning tasks

Progress Tests – PTE, PTM and PTS

- International Bench Mark for Tracking and Reporting Progress made in a year
- Grades 2 8
 - PTE (Progress Test in English) Spelling, grammar, punctuation and reading comprehension (60-75 min)
 - PTM (Progress Test in Math) Mathematical skills and knowledge (60-75 min)
 - PTS (Progress Test in Science) Science knowledge (60 min)
 - Taken at the end of every year
